VETERAN DOG (1)

1. Brown's Sh.Ch. Freebreeze American Frost of Ramsayville. 7 ½ yr old b/w who has a lovely head with a good stop giving a soft expression. Nice shape standing but would prefer slightly more front angulation. Moved well.

PUPPY DOG (5)

1. Graham & Denwood's Lyndfil Krakatau. Well grown 8 month o/w with plenty of bone. Nicely made and well balanced with good front and rear angulation. Pleasing head with kind eye and expression. Lovely free movement.
2. Wilberg's Kiswahili Martin at Kanix. Another nicely made baby, just 6 months. Good head for age with a nice dark eye and kind expression. He also has good bone, pasterns and neat feet. Good topline and tailset. Moved well. Just lost out to 1 on maturity.
3. Smith's Toberdoney Fergus.

JUNIOR DOG (3)

1. Cherry's Shanandi Madrigal. Lovely b/w youngster. He has a beautiful head, neat ears and a super dark eye giving that lovely soft expression. Good topline, tailset and quarters. Moved well using his neat tail.
2. Wilkinson's Flinthill Jumping Jack. B/w heavier build than 1. Has a nicely moulded head with a good stop. Not quite the angulation of 1, but moved well.
3. Gorrian & Henry's Head for the Hills with Donsudale.

NOVICE DOG (3,1 abs)

1. Smith's Toberdoney Fergus. B/w who was 3rd in puppy. Good head with Pronounced occiput. Reasonable forehead and topline. Moved OK.
2. Klein-Woolthuis' Haxalgate Balach Dubh. Not the angulation if 1, but has a nice head with a good stop and kind expression. Moved out well.

POST GRADUATE DOG (11,2)

1. Gordon's Hawkfield Dapper in Black JW. Have always liked this young dog. He has a beautiful head and kind eye. Good neck, shoulders, topline and quarters. Good depth of brisket and well off for bone. Moved well covering the ground and using his tail.
2. Wood's Stockend Winchester. This l/w dog has really come on. Not quite the head of 1, but has a nice neck, good shoulders, depth of brisket and good quarters with well bent stifles. Another one with good, free ground covering movement.
3. Lockwood's Bonnygate Indian Chief at Lockenna.

LIMIT DOG (7,1)

1. Smith & Carter's Medogold Dan Tastic ShCM. This is a really lovely dog and one I have admired for sometime. He has the most beautiful head and expression. So well balanced. Lovely neck and shoulders, good topline and depth of brisket. sloping pasterns and neat feet. Has lovely free flowing movement. RCC.
2. Wilson's Bonnygate Imperial Choice. Smaller all through than 1, but another who is well balanced. He has a gorgeous head with plenty of work in it. Lovely topline and tailset, good depth of brisket and spring of rib. Moved really well using his good quarters and lashing his tail.
3. Wilkinson's Hurwyn Brother Beyond.

OPEN DOG (8,1)

This was a lovely class.

1. Martin's Jilony Believe in Sunhouse ShCM. Heavily marked b/w who was on top form today. He is so well balanced, has a lovely head and expression. Good neck and excellent forehand. Well off for bone, good sloping pasterns and tight feet. Lovely topline and tailset. Good depth of brisket, quarters and bend of stifle. Really drove round the ring with his lovely free movement and using his tail.
Delighted to award him the CC and BOB.
2. Hinton & Pulsford's Sh.Ch. Tawbarn Star Eclipse of Fleurfield JW. Another lovely, well made and balanced boy. He has a lovely well balanced head with a melting expression. Good neck, shoulders, topline and tailset and good depth of brisket. Not quite the movement of 1 today, unlucky to meet him on such good form.

VETERAN BITCH (3)

1. Blower's Sharnphilly Wilma for Deadway. 7 yr. old who won this class on her lovely free movement. Pleasing head and expression, balanced outline, neat tail which she used well on the move.
2. Smith's Sh.Ch. Toberdoney Faith JW. 7 ½ year old b/w. Lovely, well proportioned head with a kind eye. Nicely made with good depth of brisket. Not the movement of 1.
3. Curran's Hurwyn Red Card Rita.

PUPPY BITCH (9,2)

1. Crawte's Bestina Black Opal at Leascliffe. What a little sweetie. B/w of just 6 months, but really caught my eye. She has a lovely head, with the darkest of eyes, and a sweet expression. Good neck and front angulation and good depth for her age. Good topline and quarters with good bend of stifle. Movement a little loose at the moment, but went well for one so young. **BP**.
2. Graham & Denwood's Lyndfil Tallahassee. 8 month b/w built on heavier lines than 1 but very balanced. Good, well proportioned head, nicely angulated body with good depth. Moved well.
3. Tibb's Raighmore Water Lily.

JUNIOR BITCH (13,4)

1. Evans & Rawling's Joneva Waiting in the Wings JW. Well balanced, typy b/w. nicely made all through with good angulation and depth of brisket. Well boned, good pasterns and neat feet. Well muscled quarters and good tailset. Lovely ground covering movement.
2. Wilkinson's Hurwyn Scissor Sister. Another lovely, well balanced b/w, longer cast than 1. Lovely head and expression, neat well set ears. Good front and rear angulation, nice topline and well sprung ribs. Moved well. Lost out to 1 on maturity today.
3. Smith & Carter's Medogold Pearl Power over Blueyonda JW.

NOVICE BITCH (6,1)

1. Tibb's Raigmore Quest. Well balanced b/w with a good head and kind expression. Has a super length of neck, is well boned with good depth of body and spring of Rib. Moved well.
2. Barker's Flinthill Jenny Wren. Nice youngster who has a lovely well moulded head with a good stop, and a nice dark eye. Not the length of neck of 1. Good body. Moved ok.
3. Klein-Woolthuis' Haxelgate Theine.

POST GRADUATE BITCH (15,1)

1. Dyer's Sharnphilly Complimentary. What a super youngster, who really caught my eye. Beautifully balanced, she has a sweet head and expression, good neck and shoulders, sloping pasterns and neat feet. Good depth of brisket and well sprung ribs. Super topline, tailset and quarters. Beautiful free movement. **CC**.
2. Wilkinson's Hurwyn Eau de Cologne. Very typy o/w. Beautiful head, although could do with slightly more length of muzzle for me, lovely dark eye giving a soft expression and a good stop. Nicely balanced, with good angulation and depth of brisket. Moved well. Close up to 1.
3. Gordon's Shanandi Raising a Riot at Hawkfield.

LIMIT BITCH (9,3)

1. Martin's Sunhouse Ice Dancer JW. Lovely well made b/w. Sweet head and expression. Super forehead, good deep brisket, sloping pasterns and neat feet. Lovely topline, good quarters and bend of stifle. Another from this kennel with super free ground covering movement.
2. Torbett's Carmelfair Bliss JW ShCM. Nicely balanced b/w who is well angulated. Good head with a kind expression. Well off for bone. Good neck and topline. Not quite the movement of 1.
3. Tibb's Toberdoney Jessica at Raigmore.

OPEN BITCH (14,3)

1. Hinton's Sh.Ch. Hookwood Pretty Woman by Fleurfield JW. Have always admired this o/w who looked a picture standing. She has a beautiful head with that lovely soft expression. She is well angulated with good depth and super quarters, lovely topline and tailset. Effortless movement. **RCC**
2. Graham & Denwood's Lyndfil Bed of Roses. B/w heavier all through than 1, but very nicely made and well balanced. Lovely feminine head, good shoulders and depth of brisket. Good topline, tailset and well muscled quarters. Another with free, effortless movement.
3. Hambling's Shanandi Tabasco with Chaseover.

My Best Veteran came from Open Dog.

Flint's Sh.Ch. Casilex Bucks Fizz. He is a b/w 8 year old who was looking very fit. He is beautifully balanced with good shoulders, quarters and depth of brisket. Nice head and expression. Moved out really well. Pleased to see he was short listed in the group.
