MINOR PUPPY DOG (6,2a)

1st Atkin's Hawkfield Mischief Maker, beautiful b/w baby of super type, excellent outline, well proportioned in head, good neck, layback of shoulder, legs & feet, pleasing depth to body for age, excellent angulation, good strength in loin & hindquarters for one so young, moved out very steadily. BPD;

2nd Blackburn-Bennett's Lokmadi Jay Todd at Kanix, bigger made o/w, slightly older, of excellent type, very sturdy with excellent ribcage & strong loin. Could have a better turn of stifle;

3rd Hamilton & Gordon's Hawkfield Loves A Scoundrel.

PUPPY DOG (3,1)

1st Osman's Wilchrimane Ace Ventura, 11 months b/w of pleasing type, good outline both standing & moving, well proportioned in head, good legs & feet, good ribcage, strong loin & hindquarters used well on the move, good in profile using his tail well;

2nd Siddle's Wilchrimane Black Ice, most pleasing 10 month old, very masculine head but rather shorter in muzzle. Good front with depth of body, strong in loin. Movement could be more positive.

JUNIOR DOG (8)

1st Martin's Sunhouse Believe It Or Not, 12 months b/w of super type, of excellent quality, good outline both standing & moving, classic head of good proportions with lovely expression, good layback, correct balanced angulation & free positive movement;

2nd Warford's Lappakia Desert Passion, slightly bigger made dog, b/w, all in proportion, beautiful head, eye & expression, well balanced angulation, free positive movement;

3rd Stangroom's Lappakia Oasis Dream.

YEARLING DOG (8)

1st O'Neill's Hurwyn Some Might Say, b/w of super type, excellent outline both standing & moving with tail lashing, beautiful head, eye & expression, good neckline & layback of shoulder, good front, legs & feet, pleasing depth to body for age, excellent well angulated, strong hindquarters giving free positive movement;

2nd Anthony's Jilony Just Amazin, another b/w of similar age, of excellent type with tail wagging, beautiful head on classic lines, excellent front, ribcage & loin, super free movement;

3rd L Oasis Dream.

NOVICE DOG (3)

1st L Desert Passion; 2 Desmond's Medogold Daramoon over Kajesola, young dog, just on 12 months, of good type, pleasing head, eye & expression, good balanced angulation, legs & feet. Not quite so settled in movement but had a good outline with tail outstretched.

POST GRADUATE DOG (11,3)

1st Radcliffe's Sniperay Solstice Sultan, big upstanding o/w, excellent type, full of substance, excellent outline in stance, all in proportion & very masculine, good head, eye & expression, good depth to body, strong in loin & hindquarters, good free ground covering movement;

2nd Warford's Hampsbeck Newtons Pride, smaller made b/w dog of excellent type, good head, pleasing depth to body, free easy movement & a good outline;

3rd Stilgoe & Millward's Teisgol Tanzanite.

LIMIT DOG (8,2)

1st Hamilton's Hawkfield Lets Get Rowdy, b/w of super type, very classy & stylish, excellent head, eye & expression, good balanced angulation, pleasing outline on the move with correct lashing tail. Still young & can only get better in maturity. Quality outlook & style with good construction which is so pleasing to the eye. CC;
2nd Wilcox's Pipeaway Zonic Tonic for Merynjen, 5 years, bigger made dog, o/w of excellent type, appealed for his overall construction & excellent outline in stance, moved out so well with a good profile;
3rd Curran's Hurwyn Jack Snipe at Breezemoor.

OPEN DOG (15,3) Excellent class with some quality Pointers exhibited headed by two super dogs.

1st Martin's Sh Ch Jilony Believe In Sunhouse, mature b/w of excellent type, most beautiful head, eye & expression, coat was gleaming in the sunshine, excellent front, legs & feet, good mature body & super free movement. RCC;
2nd Goode's Gempoint Dark 'N' Sharp at Handsway, b/w of excellent type, so very similar & well constructed all through with super free ground covering movement. After making an initial decision when they were standing at either end of the long line of 12 dogs, on bringing them together I just preferred the head & expression of the 1, hence my final decision;
3rd Swift's Hampsbeck Chaos.

MINOR PUPPY BITCH (5,2)

1st Howes' Medogold Double Dizzy, just on 8 months, of pleasing type, excellent outline & stance, beautiful head, eye & expression, good neck, legs & feet, pleasing layback of shoulder, well developed in body, good ribcage, good angulation, well turned stifle & free easy movement. Nice to see her dam was my RCC. She kept up her good performance to go BP & showed impeccably to go PG3;
2nd Gordon's Tomlow Look Whos Here at Hawkfield, b/w of beautiful type, just 6 months, coat shining with condition, feminine head of good proportions, good legs & feet, balanced angulation & free steady movement;
3rd Thorley's Teddyhawks Athena at Gempoint.

PUPPY BITCH (7,1)

1st Medogold Double Dizzy;
2nd Dunn's Meadowpoint Spirit Dancer, of excellent type & full of quality, pleasing outline both standing & moving, good head, eye & expression, well developed in ribcage & loin, good turn of stifle, pleasing free movement;
3rd Anthony's Jilony Justa Sensation.

JUNIOR BITCH (10,1)

1st Martin's Sunhouse Believe In Me, b/w, just 12 months of super type, in gleaming coat & condition, well proportioned in head, very feminine with good reach of neck & layback of shoulder, well developed in body for age, free ground covering movement;
2nd Tannahill's Wynbury Antonina, b/w of similar age of excellent type, loveliest head, eye & expression, well balanced angulation, good depth to body, pleasing free movement;
3rd Lowe's Lowsmoor Storms River.

YEARLING BITCH (11,3)

1st Blowers' Bonnygate Karriage Queen of Deadway, excellent type, b/w, super pointing outline both standing & on the move, lovely feminine head of good proportions, excellent neck & shoulders, good legs & neat feet, excellent tail carriage, sound free movement;
2nd Kiddy's Medogold Be My Baby at Millpoint, l/w of excellent type, beautiful head, eye & expression, clean neckline, well laid shoulders. Needs yet to fill out in loin but a lovely bitch showing off her virtues to advantage;
3rd Fallan's Medogold Velvetini.

NOVICE BITCH (8,2)

1st Wynbury Antonina;
2nd Lowsmoor Storms River, b/w of good type, gained more confidence in this class, moved out very well & gave a good profile standing;
3rd Lambert's Smart Bay Vintage Gold.

POST GRADUATE BITCH (15,4)

1st Shaw's Sativus All About Eve, b/w of excellent type, sound movement, beautiful head, eye & expression, excellent neckline, layback of shoulder & topline, good legs & feet, super movement in profile, lovely outline both standing & moving;
2nd Medogold Velvetini, good clean outline, head of good proportions, good depth to body & strong in loin, moved out well to gain this place;
3rd Sillince's Tomlow Night And Day.

LIMIT BITCH (10,3)

1st Walton's Esrews Serenade at Pointmoor, 5 years b/w of super type, excellent construction all through, showed off her attributes to advantage, excellent profile with tail lashing, mature & sound with excellent movement;
2nd Coggins' Medogold Bewitched to Gemrose, slightly younger bitch, coat gleaming with condition, is mature with excellent construction & so feminine, excellent legs & feet, good ground cover on the move;
3rd Siddle's Wilchrimane Fleur-De-Lys.

OPEN BITCH (11,2)

1st Evans & Rawlings' Sh Ch Joneva Waiting In The Wings, super bitch of excellent type, in stance has a superb outline with excellent construction, made right to move right, is certainly fit for function, making a beautiful picture in profile, with her tail lashing, as she soars round the ring showing off her virtues to advantage. CC & BOB;
2nd Howes' Peakdale Perdido Plays Medogold, l/w of excellent type, so very similar in build with all the attributes of the breed, moved out so well using her hocks & tail to advantage, excellent outline in profile. RCC;
3rd Swift's Hampsbeck Maybe Mabel.
