MINOR PUPPY DOG (5)

1st Marsh's Sharnphilly Redshank for Ratchda, nice head & eye, clean neck, well laid shoulders, good turn of stifle, well balanced throughout & very steady movement for a youngster;

2nd Tricker's Sharnphilly Razorbill, litter brothers so similar remarks apply at the moment, 1 has a little more ring presence;

3rd Wilberg's Wynbury Hawker Hector at Kanix.

PUPPY DOG (6)

1st Evans & Rawlings' Joneva Stubbs, not the biggest of dogs but balanced throughout, well shaped head of quality proportions, clean neck, good shoulder placement, correct topline, good tailset, sound precise movement;

2nd Ward's Pipeaway Dizzee Rascal at Caleta, good front assembly, pleasing head, nice neat feet, good turn of stifle, longer coupled than 1;

3rd Warford's Lappakia Desert Passion.

JUNIOR DOG (4,2a)

1st Williams & Rose's Kanix Ace at Ridanflight, balanced head, good eye & earset, plenty of bone, correct shoulder & rear assembly, tight feet, moved soundly with drive;

2nd Cooper's Esrews Jazz Seriously, pleasing head, dark pigmentation, topline with slight slope, good turn of stifle, tail well set & of correct length, at the moment showing a little daylight underneath.

NOVICE DOG (4,1)

1st Stangroom's Lappakia Oasis Dream, giving handler a hard time, good head, dark eye, well shaped, clean neck, good topline & nice turn of stifle, these two dogs were moving a little wide behind today, the ground was very hard & I wondered if this was the reason;

2nd Desmond's Medogold Daramoon over Kajesola, similar remarks to 1;

3rd Kelleher's Teisgol Sancerre.

POST GRADUATE DOG (11,1)

1st -RCC, Drake's Clamerkin Crystal Mountain, took my eye in a very strong class, well balanced head with plenty of work, dark well shaped eye giving intelligent expression, deep brisket, well bodied, moved with style & purpose;

2nd Radcliffe's Sniperay Solstice Sultan, heavier in front than 1 but pleasing head, dark eye, clean neck, deep chest, well bodied, good tailset & carriage, moved well;

3rd Gordon's Hawkfield Lets Go Crackers.

LIMIT DOG (9,2)

1st Beesley's Birchleith Barbican Beau, won on stylish sound movement, not a big boy but well balanced, pleasing head, dark eye, nice shaped ears well set, adequate body, neat tail well carried;

2nd Wilberg's Jilony Freedom with Kanix, good head, neck & shoulders, deep brisket, correct oval bone, well muscled, good turn of stifle;

3rd Siddle's Wilchrimane Obe Gold.

OPEN DOG (9,2)

1st -CC & BOB, Wilberg & Blackburn-Bennett's Sh Ch Kiswahili Martin at Kanix, one who has been reported on regularly & I think everything has been said but his movement could not be ignored, he strides round the ring with power & still holding his topline all the time;
2nd Moulding's Sh Ch Billsborough's Bright Moon, standing presents a lovely picture but today was not putting his all in his movement, good head & front, plenty of body, nice turn of stifle & neat feet, well padded;
3rd Howes' Medogold Funtime Frankie.

VETERAN (3)

1st Naden's Sh Ch Trendmere Dark Star over Witchwood, well balanced bitch with classic head & dark eye, well bodied & deep brisket, good topline, moved sprightly not showing her age at all;
2nd Welch's Sh Ch/Ir Sh Ch Hookwood Top Man, in top condition, no grey, pleasing head, good front & rear assembly, topline was kept standing & on the move;
3rd Radcliffe's Sniperay Pussy Galore.

MINOR PUPPY BITCH (3)

1st Tannahill's Wynbury Antonina, very steady for a youngster, balanced head, dark eye, well shaped, correct set & length of ear, well bodied;
2nd Radcliffe's Sniperay Highland Spring, just would not settle, shows great promise if her handler can just get her confidence sorted;
3rd Stilgoe's Teisgol Under The Mistletoe.

PUPPY BITCH (7,1)

1sy Smith's Hookwood Tickadeeboo Say Lypal, 10 months or/w, sweet head, dark pigmentation, correct oval bone, well bodied, good turn of stifle, moved true;
2nd Blackburn-Bennett's Kanix Beatrice, good overall shape, plenty of body, strong rearquarters, just needs to tighten up in her front movement;
3rd Simmons' Calderside Songbird at Honeywood.

JUNIOR BITCH (10,2)

1st Blowers' Bonnygate Karriage Queen of Deadaway, pretty bitch, feminine head, good front, deep brisket, well sprung ribs, good turn of stifle, nice tailset & shape used on the move;
2nd Bond's Pharises Aphrodites, similar remarks apply to 1, 1 just had the edge on movement today.

NOVICE BITCH (6)

1st Tannahill's Wynbury Antonina;
2nd Simmons' Calderside Song Bird at Honeywood, liver/w, did not look as if she was enjoying her day, held her ears back & gave a hard expression, good front, plenty of body, well off for bone, would like to see her more settled;
3rd Welch's Hookwood Back To Black.

POST GRADUATE BITCH (13)

1st Stangroom's Medogold Wannabeposh for Lappakia, up to size, well balanced, good head with soft expression, correct dentition, tight feet, well arched toes, good front, clean front, well bodied, good tailset & carriage, moved well;
2nd Symonds' Medogold Kalandra at Tanafei, pretty head, dark eye, well placed shoulders, good topline, neat feet, used her tail on the move;
3rd Spinks & Rayner's Spinray Miss Saigon.

LIMIT BITCH (6)

1st -RCC, Coggins' Medogold Bewitched to Gemrose, was a close contender for top honours but just spoilt the picture by carrying a little too much weight, pleasing head, dark eye, neat clean lines, correct oval bone, tight feet, moved soundly;

2nd Crawte's Bestina Black Opal at Leascliffe, have seen & admired this bitch in the past & standing she was a picture but I was a little disappointed when she moved, did not put any effort in here, maybe it was due to the extremely hot day;

3rd Rose & Williams' Ridanflight Rangiora.

OPEN BITCH (8)

1st - CC, Evans & Rawlings' Joneva Waiting In The Wings, good head with plenty of chiselling, lovely dark eyes, good front & neat feet, well sprung ribs, deep brisket, sound quarters, just the right amount of muscle, moved with drive & style;

2nd Howes' Sh Ch Medogold Vanilla Fudge, good head & eye, correct dentition, clean arched neck, strong quarters, deep chest, moved well but would just like a pound off to balance the picture;

3rd Blackburn-Bennett's Chesterhope North N Breeze at Kanix.
