Many believe the head is the hallmark of the breed & the tail, quality & purity. I believe you not only need a typical head & tail but everything in-between & movement too, so as always I was looking for type, quality, correct conformation with true Pointer movement & attitude. Overall I had a quality entry & was pleased with my winners. Heads & tail carriage I found generally improved. However, thick heads, long ears, loaded shoulders & upright front assembly are appearing & of concern. There was diversification in type as one can expect & some difficult decisions. On a different day & places change.

MINOR PUPPY DOG (5)

1st Rayner, Spinks & Pringle's Tenshilling It's Now Or Never at Spinray, immature o/w of good type, nice lines & bone, pretty head, balanced angulation, well muscled;
2nd Mitchell's Tenshilling That's All Right for Staxyll, o/w, brother to 1, similar in type but not quite the body & lines;
3rd Roberts & Easton's Fanmatrix Serious Sirius.

PUPPU DOG (7)

1st Evans & Pavey's Joneva Diamond In The Rough, handsome o/w with good bone, defined head, good eye, neat ears, long muscular neck into well laid shoulders, good rib, depth & forechest. Defined first & second thigh, well muscled hard condition, moved with reach & drive. BP;
2nd Barrs-Gordon's Panoply Gold Vision, strongly made stylish o/w with good body, bone & lots to like, in hard condition using his well developed hindquarters to move powerfully. Preferred the head & front angulation of 1;
3rd Yeo's Trexon Let It Loose.

JUNIOR DOG (9)

1st Theobald's Tycarreg Strangely Familyr, typy b/w with chiselled head & dish face, muscular neck, good shoulder angulation, bone, rib & depth, moved soundly;
2nd Welch's Hookwood Top This, impressive b/w with lots to like, pleasing head, muscular neck, good rib & depth, well developed hindquarters, first & second thigh. Needs to relax on the move;
3rd Bradley's Teisgol King Alfred.

YEARLING DOG (6)

1st Fox's Tenshilling I Get Around to Dappleline, scopy o/w, attractive head, long neck, good rib, condition, bone & hind angulation, covered plenty of ground when moving which won him the class;

2nd Whitham's Moordale Maritime at Sedgekirk, neat b/w with pleasing defined head, nice type, good body, hard condition, moved sound & true holding his topline;

3rd Wilcox's Scobec Man In The Mirror at Merynjen.

POST GRADUATE DOG (7)

1st Whitham's Moordale Maritime at Sedgekirk;

2nd Atkin's Hawkfield Mischief Maker for Guanabara, b/w with well developed head & good lip, good topline, rib & hind angulation. Not the strength on the move of 1;

3rd Stangroom's Lappakia Oasis Dream.

LIMIT DOG (11)

1st Kirby's Haramander Shabby Chic, classy o/w, lovely head & expression, so much in the right place, super type & movement. RCC;

2nd O'Neill's Hurwyn Some Might Say, stylish b/w with pleasing head & soft expression, balanced angulation with good rib & depth, sound, positive movement;

3rd Harris' Scobec Man About Time.

OPEN DOG (7)

1st Smith & Hook's Medogold Dantastic, strongly made quality b/w in gleaming hard condition, lovely defined head, good lip & muzzle, good angulation fore & aft, super rib & depth, powerful stylish mover covering plenty of ground. CC;

2nd Rose & Robinson's NZ Ch Robwyn Dreams Are Free at Ridanflight, typy o/w with lots to like, pleasing head & expression, strong body, good bone. Preferred the shoulders & movement of 1;

3rd Wilson's Sh Ch Joneva Shooting Star at Djankay.

GOOD CITIZEN DOG SCHEME DOG

1st Stangroom's Lappakia Oasis Dream, upstanding o/w, balanced angulation, good length of neck & rib, pleasing head, moved on well.

VETERAN BITCH (2)

1st MacManus' Crookrise Arran at Luneville, typy o/w, neat all through, nicely balanced, in hard condition;

2nd Cardiff's Clamerkin Classy Catalina at Prosperity, b/w, well made, in hard condition. Preferred movement of 1.

MINOR PUPPY BITCH (10)

- 1st O'Neill's Tenshilling Viva Las Vegas, o/w in good condition, defined head for age, good neck, rib & bone, moved with reach & drive;
2nd Welch's Ilfield Jenny, b/w, well made with nicely chiselled head, strong body, positive on the move;
3rd Perkin's Luneville Joney Moon at Brent.

PUPPY BITCH (11)

- 1st Evans & Pavey's Joneva Hazy Hazy Dream, o/w, delightful head & eye, melting expression, neat correctly shaped ears, long muscular arched neck into well laid shoulders, good forechest, super rib & depth, strong topline, good croup, moved truly with reach & drive;
2nd Siddle's Wilchrime Ice Maiden, stylish o/w when viewed across the ring. Preferred the head, front assembly & balance of 1;
3rd Cherry's Chaseover Twinkling Star.

JUNIOR BITCH (7)

- 1st Smith & Hook's Blueyonda Whitty Banter, strongly made o/w who makes a good picture standing & moving, excellent front & hind angulation, appealing head & expression, lengthy muscular neck, good rib, depth & bone, neat tail, moved with reach & drive;
2nd Blackburn-Bennett's Lokmadi Martina at Kanix, o/w of good type, preferred the shoulders, angles & movement of 1;
3rd Bedson & Earl's Caithpoint Sugar Babe.

YEARLING BITCH (11)

- 1st Craik's Scobec Ice Maiden, elegant o/w of lovely type, pretty head, neat ears, long neck, well made all through with good rib & depth, moved truly holding her topline;
2nd O'Neill's Tenshilling Do It Again, scopy o/w, good type, pleasing head & expression, good body, balanced angulation, moved well. Preferred the head of 1;
3rd Andrews & Ledger's Ir Sh Ch Aurichalcum Miss Tified Ledgands JW Ir June Ch.

POST GRADUATE BITCH (18)

- 1st Lowe's Lowsmoor Storms River, caught my eye across the ring, smart b/w with lots to like, well made all through, held her shape standing & moving;
2nd Dunn's Meadowpoint Spirit Dancer, free-moving b/w with lovely head, quality bitch. Preferred the shape & flow of 1;
3rd Blower's Bonnygate Karriage Queen of Deadaway.

LIMIT BITCH (10)

1st Hinton's Fieldstone Fascination with Fleurfield, elegant b/w, gently chiselled head, kind expression, long neck into well laid shoulders, super front & hind angulation, correct rib & depth, bone & pasterns, flowed round the ring moving correctly, stood out for the class. CC, BOB & G4;

2nd Drake's Clamerkin Crystal Lace, free-moving o/w with lots to like all through, pleasing head, super rib, depth, bone & condition, didn't put a foot wrong. RCC;

3rd Craik's Scobec Pure Passion.

OPEN BITCH (6)

1st Crawte's Sh Ch Bestina Black Opal at Leascliffe, strongly made quality b/w, pleasing head, balanced angulation, in lovely condition, moved well;

2nd Craik's Scobec Bi Deezign, pleasing b/w, not overdone, lots to like, moved & showed well;

3rd Cardiff's Prosperity My Fair Lady.

GOOD CITIZEN DOG SCHEME BITCH (3)

1st Blower's Bonnygate Karriage Queen of Deadaway, typy b/w, neat all through, pleasing head & expression, good neck, rib & bone, in hard condition, moved well;

2nd Stangroom's Lappakia Dune Song, o/w, pleasing head & neck, lovely lines, super body in muscular hard condition, just not putting all in on the move.
