1<sup>ST</sup> Blackburn's Kanix Fredrik, b/w, super young dog, put together with no exaggeration. Balanced all through head, good length of foreface, stop, pronounced occiput, lovely neck & slope of shoulder, good length of upper arm, flowing topline without steep rise. Good expanse of thigh, low driving hocks, moved true on good length of stride.

2<sup>ND</sup> Siddle & Oddie's Wilchrimane Igoyougo, lovely outline, teeming with quality, loved his whole demure. Should go far. Close up to 1;

3<sup>RD</sup> Martin's Sunhouse Anything Goes.

### **JUNIOR DOG (5)**

1<sup>ST</sup> Goode's Handsway Perfect Storm, beautiful head & expression, loved his forehand & topline. Just off level tailset just right. Low set hock that he can use, moved on good length;

2<sup>ND</sup> Dodds' Raigmore Light Up The Sky for Lyncarda, o/w, so well put together, strong quarters, width of thigh, length of tail set on well, liked his pasterns;

3<sup>RD</sup> Tibbs' Raigmore Shine From Afar.

### **POST GRADUATE DOG (9)**

1<sup>ST</sup> McNab's Shanandi Dark Shadow of Querdon, b/w of quality, moved like a dream, got the mark of crusader. On the finer side, liked his head, topline & sheer charisma. Used his tail all the time, good to see;

2<sup>ND</sup> Mason's Freebreeze Figaro, o/w, well put together, liked his head, well ribbed up, spring & depth, good turn of stifle;

3<sup>RD</sup> Marsh's Sharnphilly Redshank for Ratchda.

### **LIMIT DOG (5)**

1<sup>ST</sup> Smith's Toberdoney Fergus at Fydal, b/w, all dog, best of shoulders & forehand, so well balanced, his tail never stopped, moved sound;

2<sup>ND</sup> Klein-Woolthuis' Haxalgate Balach Dubh, close up b/w, so strong & dynamic, all Pointer. Loved his tail & sweep over stile. The first three in this class such lovely movers;

3<sup>RD</sup> Lavery & McNab's Gideon The Profiler.

### **OPEN DOG (7)**

1<sup>ST</sup> Andrews & Ledger's Ir/DE/NL/Lux/Int Sh Ch Ledgands Magic N Mayhem, o/w, the best head on show here, all quality & ring presence. Well ribbed up, good bone, lovely resilient pasterns, low driving hocks. Never seen him look better. Carrying just the right weight, good muscletone, full of health & vigour, so clean from neck into shoulder. CC;

2<sup>ND</sup> O'Driscoll's Ch Fowington Five Bob Note, b/w, super dog, balanced all through from head to tail, best of ribbing, lovely shoulder & upper arm, lovely tight feet, moved on good stride;

3<sup>RD</sup> Blackburn-Bennett's Sh Ch Kiswahili Martin at Kanix.

### **VETERAN DOG (1)**

1<sup>ST</sup> Mason's Aurichalcum The Renegade, looking so well for nearly 10 years. Lovely head & expression, liked width of thigh, topline, well off for bone.

**PUPPY BITCH (5)**

1<sup>ST</sup> Dyer's Sharnphilly Juici Cuture, 11 months l/w, best of heads, neck & shoulder, good length of upper arm, strong quarters, flowing topline. Nice feel to coat, moved on good length. One to watch;  
2<sup>ND</sup> Hewitt's Sunhouse As You Like It, b/w, lots of work in her head, clean neck & shoulder, flowing topline, moved freely;  
3<sup>RD</sup> McDougall's Daledancer Cool Dawn at Wyndhead.

**JUNIOR BITCH (7)**

1<sup>ST</sup> O'Driscoll's Fowington One Won One, b/w, full of quality, best of forehands, flowing topline, liked her strong quarters with expanse of thigh, pronounced second thigh. Just loved her from head to tail, all Pointer with no exaggeration. CC & BOB;  
2<sup>ND</sup> Jones & Hinton's Pippalee Georgia by Fleurfield, moved so sound & full of verve, resilient in pastern, driving hocks. A little longer cast than 1;  
3<sup>RD</sup> Andrews & Ledger's Sunny Side Up at Ledgands.

**POST GRADUATE BITCH (7)**

1<sup>ST</sup> O'Neill's Tenshilling Viva Las Vegas, o/w, good in shoulder length of upper arm, liked her topline & underline, spring of rib, bee sting tail & width of thigh. Moved on a decent length;  
2<sup>ND</sup> Burnett's Caithpoint Spice Girl, o/w, good forehand, well ribbed up, sweep over stifle, good feel to coat, moved sound;  
3<sup>RD</sup> Cooper's Keepersfield Mama Mia.

**LIMIT BITCH (10)**

1<sup>ST</sup> Callander's Fleurfield Felicia of Shambellie, balanced all through, loved her head, neck & shoulder, strong quarters, bone & tight feet, moved so very sound, lovely dark orange to her coat helped her stand out. RCC;  
2<sup>ND</sup> Dyer's Sharnphilly Auckland, b/w, good reach of neck into fine sloping shoulder, flowing topline, best of forehands, tail set on nicely, moved very sound;  
3<sup>RD</sup> O'Neill's Tenshilling Do It Again.

**OPEN BITCH (9)**

1<sup>ST</sup> Hinton's Sh Ch Fieldstone Fascination with Fleurfield, b/w, lovely bitch, put together well, liked her forehand, upper arm, width of thigh, low set hock & has much quality. Moved on a good stride over plenty of ground;  
2<sup>ND</sup> Blackburn-Bennett's Kanix Chilli, balanced, well off for bone, good in pastern, best of ribcage, bee sting tail set on just right, flowing topline, moved sound on good length;  
3<sup>RD</sup> Tibbs' Sh Ch/Ir Sh Ch Raigmore Let It Shine.
