VETERAN DOG OR BITCH (1)

1st Cardiff's Prosperity My Fair Lady ShCM Lemon/W Lovely bitch not looking her age. Good all through; moved well, really enjoying her day out. **BV**

MINOR PUPP DOG (3)

- 1st Reed's Digbyvalley Horacio Nelson B/W Only 6 month old baby. Behaved extremely well for his handler. Excellent body properties and moved well.
- 2nd Blackburn-Bennett and Wilberg's Coralwood Kanix Mr T, O/W Upstanding puppy again good body properties and beautiful outline; not as steady on the move as 1.
- 3rd Huxley's Aurichalcum Evan Knows its Woodfleet.

PUPPY DOG (4,1)

- 1st Welch's Hookwood Only Me B/W Good to go over; good bone, feet, rear angulation; pleasing head; steady on the move
- 2nd Isherwood's Symitry Red Rascal O/W Lovely head with melting expression; good body properties all through; took some time to settle on the move.

JUNIOR DOG (8,1)

- 1st Watkins & Davies' Hurwyn Law N Order B/W Impressive dog of correct size; lovely head and expression; well angulated with correct bone and feet; moved well using tail. **RDCC**
- 2nd Crawte's Leascliffe Luis B/W Another nice dog; good body properties; built on bigger lines than one but not overdone; steady mover
- 3rd Tregaskis' Moenfair Choirboy.

YEARLING DOG (8)

- 1st Tobin & Moss' Davigdor Rough and Tumble JW O/W All through a well constructed dog; good head and expression; moved well but unfortunately in the challenge lacked animation.
- 2nd Golding's Sharnphilly Louis Vuitton L/W another well constructed dog; moved well; preferred head of 1. 3rd Cardiff's Prosperity Va Va Voom JW

POST GRADUATE DOG (7,1)

- 1st Desmond's Medogold Daramoon Over Kajesola B/W Handsome dog; pleasing head; well angulated with good bone and feet; moved well.
- 2nd Grantham & Moss' Kiswahili Quantum of Solace at Kingspoint B/W Substantial dog; initially took some time to settle which spoiled his general outline but pleasing all through and steady on the move. 3rd Bell's Crookrise The Medlar at Owlspoint.
