JUNIOR DOG (4,1a)

1st Cummings' Kanix Kroner at Sevenhills, best of outlines & balanced. Nice depth of chest. Good neck. Lovely well proportioned head & open nose. Good length & width of upper & lower thigh. Moved well on neat feet;
2nd Tobin & Moss' Davigdor Reference Point, little upright in front but rear angulation OK. Good depth of chest & spring of rib. Nicely proportioned head. Good length of neck. Moved better behind than in front;
3rd Robertson & O'Brien's Hookwood Peacemaker.

POST GRADUATE DOG (1)

1st Perkins' Brent Ticker For One, nicely balanced head with nice chiselling under eye. Good neck & shoulder. Excellent depth of chest & good spring of rib going back to strong loin. Nicely muscled throughout. Good length of upper & lower thigh. Moved a little close in front but covered ground well.

LIMIT DOG (3)

1st Perkins' Kanix Joker Of Brent, preferred front movement of my winner here. Nicely balanced. Nice eye & expression. Good chiselling around the eye & neat ears. Good length of neck & depth of chest. Good forechest & correct topline. Good length of upper & lower thigh. Moved well on neat feet;
2nd Tobin & Moss' Davigdor Rough And Tumble, lovely outline. Excellent length of neck, lay of shoulder & depth of chest. Nice head, eye & large open nose. Moved well really covering the ground on neat feet but front movement not too typical;
3rd McNab's Shanandi Dark Shadow of Querdon.

OPEN DOG (4,2)

1st Blackburn-Bennett & Wilberg's Coralwood Kanix Mr T, nicely developed throughout & shown in excellent muscular condition. Excels in forechest & depth of chest. Typical topline & well developed over the loin. Good length of upper & lower thigh. Nice eye & expression with large, open nose. Covered the ground well on the move & moved soundly on neat feet. CC;
2nd Perkins' Ir Sh Ch Kanix Fate Of Brent, very close up to winner. Typical, balanced outline & let down hocks. Nicely balanced, well proportioned head with good eye & intelligent expression. Moved well but not quite as ground covering nor as tight in front as 1. RCC.

JUNIOR BITCH (1)

1st Fleming's Rafterhouse Clarissa of Glenariff, feminine head. Nice outline with sufficient bone. Excellent forechest, good lay of shoulder & spring of rib. Good length of upper & lower thigh. Moved soundly on neat feet. Carrying a little too much weight on the day.

POST GRADUATE BITCH (1)

1st Ward & Blackburn-Bennett's Kanix Just A Rumour by Jakobstown, feminine head with good length of muzzle to skull ratio. Nice eye & expression. Good forechest & depth of chest. Excellent lay of shoulder & return of upper arm. Pleasing length & width of upper & lower thigh. Moved soundly on neat feet but not covering ground very well.

LIMIT BITCH (3)

1st Ward's Kiswahili Timely Nu Edition to Jakobstown, really stood out in this class. Shown in excellent condition & with a lovely outline. Well balanced head with pleasing eye & expression. Nice neck & excellent lay of shoulder & return of upper arm. Excellent depth of chest & spring of rib leading to strong short loin. Excellent hindquarters. Moved soundly on neat feet;

2nd Tobin & Moss' Davigdor Diamond Lil, very feminine & out of a smaller mound. Nicely balanced outline. Good neck, shoulders & return of upper arm. Not as tight in front as winner & a little narrower in muzzle. Covered ground well on the move;

3rd McNab's Querdon Quaver.

OPEN BITCH (4)

1st Dyer's Sh Ch Sharnphilly Juici Cuture, such a beautiful bitch, outstanding in head & outline & shown in excellent muscular condition. Beautiful head & eye with melting expression. Best of fronts. Lovely depth of chest, spring of rib & well developed over loin. Excellent topline. Excellent length & width of upper & lower thigh. Moved like a dream on neat feet & displaying strong, lengthy pasterns. CC, BOB, very pleased to watch her be awarded G4;

2nd Blackburn-Bennett's Sh Ch Kanix Chilli, another lovely bitch. Well muscled with excellent forechest. Lovely front, depth of chest, spring of rib & nicely developed hindquarters. Moved soundly really covering the ground well. Just preferred the melting expression of 1. RCC;

3rd Roses' Ridanflight Rhonwen.
