VETERAN DOG

1st Marsh's Ch Sharnpilly Redshank for Rachda, 7 years b/w, lovely head & eye shape. Good for neck & shoulder placement. Depth & strength through body. Well made quarters. Moves sound. BV;

2nd Gordon's Hawkfield Dapper, 9 years, lovely head & eye, kind expression. Good body proportions. Sound on the move.

MINOR PUPPY DOG

1st Macara, Jamieson & Blackburn Bennett's Kanix Legend at Cromasiag, lovely puppy to go over. Loved the head shape, good for neck & shoulder placement, has the depth for age. Moved with precise movement;

2nd Edmondson & Robertshaw's Crookrise Agathis, just preferred the head of 1. Good in neck & shoulder. Not quite the length in upper arm. Enough depth for age. Moved sound;

3rd Langridge's Blueyonda Bertie Wooster with Badger Moon.

PUPPY DOG

1st Harrison's Millpoint Formula One, well up to size for age but fits his frame. Liked the head shape. Shoulders well placed, good depth in body & strength in rear end. Covered the ground on the move;

2nd Best's Sunhouse Show Stopper at Bestina, nice head shape, immature at the moment. Needs to grow & develop. Moved sound.

JUNIOR DOG

1st Hazeltine & Welch's Just Wilburt, medium size youngster with lots to like. Balanced profile, kind head. Shoulders well placed, good depth & strength through body. Well muscled quarters, sound ground covering movement;

2nd Abbot & Wilberg's Larchwood Star Chaser at Kanix, rangier type in profile, liked the head & eye shape, clean in front, OK for shoulder placement. Well made quarters. Sound;

3rd Turnbull's Bonnygate Marquis O' The Glen.

YEARLING DOG

1st Rayner, Spinks & Pringle's Freebreeze Over The Top at Spinray, liked him for head, neck & shoulders. Depth in brisket, decent length rib, good over the loin & backend;

2nd Macara's Kanix Kingdom over Cromasaig, lovely headed dog, needs to develop all through to fit his frame. Moved soundly;

3rd Walkling, Graham & Moss' Aspyre Counting Sheep at Kiswahili.

NOVICE DOG

1st Wall's Meadowpoint Spirit Of Fire, alone here. Head needs more work in it. OK for neck & shoulder placement. Depth through body. Sound.

GRADUATE DOG

1st Tregaskis' Moenfair Spicewood Summer, liked the head & eye, well laid shoulders, good depth & strength in body, good in quarters/ Moved sound.

POST GRADUATE DOG

- 1st Goodes' Millpoint Yeah Baby Yeah, lovely head & eye shape. Well placed shoulders, depth in body, nicely sprung ribcage. Strong over the loin. Moves easy over the ground;
- 2nd Tregaskis' Moenfair Choirboy, lovely headed dog, preferred shoulder placement of 1. Just needs a bit more depth. OK in rear end. Moves sound.

LIMIT DOG

- 1st Hazeltine & Upton's Hookwood By George, loved this well balanced dog. Super head & eye. Well placed in shoulder. Good depth in body with well turned stifles, moved sound & true. RCC;
- 2nd Howes' Millpoint Babe Magnet at Medogold, another nice dog easy to go over. Liked the head, neck & shoulder. Strength through body & backend. Just preferred 1's ground covering movement;
- 3rd Tobin & Moss' Davigdor Rough And Tumble.

OPEN DOG

- 1st Harrison's Sh Ch Millpoint Heatwave, loved this dog for size & type, balanced & sound throughout. Lovely head & eye shape, correct in lay of shoulder, plenty of heartroom & strength in body. Developed backend. Sound true movement. CC;
- 2nd Coggins' Sh Ch Droveborough Born To Bound at Gemrose, another well put together dog. Kind expression. Good for shoulder placement, not quite upper arm of 1, ample width of chest, strong backend. Lets himself down in front movement;
- 3rd Welch's Ir Sh Ch Moolou Minstrel at Hookwood.

SPECIAL WORKING GUNDOG DOG

- 1st Marsh's Ch Sharnpilly Redshank for Rachda;
- 2nd Edmondson & Robertshaw's Crookrise Aguthis, finer in head, OK in body proportions, well muscled rear end. Moved sound;
- 3rd Anderson-Rowell's Little Owl Scandiaca for Daledancer.

VETERAN BITCH

- 1st Lowe's Lowsmoor Storms River, lovely balanced with a kind eye. Clean over the shoulder, depth in brisket, strong over backend. Moved sound;
- 2nd Harrison's Sh Ch Medogold Be My Baby at Millpoint, super headed bitch, OK in neck & shoulder. Depth & strength through body, developed in rear. Just preferred movement of 1;
- 3rd Turton's Tanglebrook Pollyanna.

MINOR PUPPY BITCH

- 1st Anthony's Jilony Top Class, a top class she is at 6 months & a day. Beautiful head & eye. Correct in shoulder, ample reach of neck. Enough body depth for age. Well built hindquarters. Moved round the ring foot perfect. Hope she grows on. BP;
- 2nd Edmonson & Robershaw's Crookrise Larch, lovely headed feminine bitch, enough lay of shoulder. Good depth for age, strong backend. Sound on the move;
- 3rd Cogan's Bradgate Take To The Hills.

PUPPY BITCH

- 1st Stilgoe & Oliver's Asterope Lightning Star via Teisgol, pretty head, nice kind eye. Ample lay of shoulder, good for depth in body, strength in quarters Moves easy over the ground;
2nd Anthony's Jilony Top Priority, litter sister to MP, not quite the confidence. Liked the head shape, ample lay of shoulder, good backend. Moved well when settled;
3rd Smith's Fydal Bedazzle.

JUNIOR BITCH

- 1st Cooper & Hinton's Carmandine Cover Girl by Fleurfield, tidy little bitch maturing the right way. Liked her head, neck & shoulder placement. She has good depth & strength over rear end. Covers the ground on easy action;
2nd Lowe's Lowsmoor Shiralee, nice feminine bitch to go over, liked the head shape, preferred the shoulder placement of 1. Good body proportions, developing backend. Sound mover;
3rd Grimes & Riley's Ansona Linnet.

YEARLING BITCH

- 1st Cooper & Hinton's Carmandine Cover Girl by Fleurfield;
2nd Flint's Wynsbury Golden Challis by Fleurfield, liked her head & eye shape. Good for length of neck. Enough depth in brisket, OK in ribbing. Good backend. Sound on the move;
3rd Dunn's Meadowpoint Spirit Of Love.

NOVICE BITCH

- 1st Cooper & Hinton's Carmandine Cover Girl by Fleurfield;
2nd Flint's Wynsbury Golden Challis by Fleurfield;
3rd Roberts' Fanmatrix Oh What A Night.

GRADUATE BITCH

- 1st Tobin & Moss' Davigdor Diamond Lil, loved her head & expression, balanced all through. Ample lay of shoulder, good for heartroom & depth in brisket. Strong back end, moves sound;
2nd Brooksmith & Adams' Nightgold Blackavar, pleased in head, decent lay of shoulder. Good for depth & strength, developing backend. Sound;
3rd Dyke's Raigmore Starlet at Briartor.

POST GRADUATE BITCH

- 1st Westerway's Penwest Pica Pica, liked this bitch to go over, kind eye, clean in throat, shoulders well placed. Good for width of chest, let down in brisket. Strength over the loin & backend. Sound easy stride;
2nd Pimblett's Pennine Pastiche, bigger made but fits her frame well. Liked the head & eye shape. Shoulders well placed, plenty of heartroom & depth in body. Does not settle on the move but sound;
3rd Salt's Pennine Passion.

LIMIT BITCH

1st Stukey's Medogold Coralie of Pendan, lovely bitch this, so easy to go over. Balanced. Super head & eye shape. Clean over the shoulder. Depth in body, strength in backend. Covers the ground on an even stride. RCC;

2nd Hookwood's Its A Kind of Magic at Kielderpoint, another lovely bitch. Super head shape, stands on a good front with shoulders well placed, ample width of chest & depth through body. Developed backend & sound on the move;

3rd Purdy's Medogold Putting On The Style for Cascagnia.

OPEN BITCH

1st Dyer's Sh Ch Sharnphily Juici Cuture, she is a picture standing & moving. Pleased to award her 30th CC, BOB, & RBIS. Well done;

2nd Bedson & Earl's Sh Ch Caithpoint Sugar Babe, lovely feminine bitch to go over. Super head & expression, shoulders well laid, plenty of heartroom with depth & strength all through. Developed quarters, ample turn of stifle. Sound easy action;

3rd Turton's Tanglebrook Madrilen.
