MINOR PUPPY DOG (5)

1st Watkins & Davies' Ansona Aladdin, very promising young man of good size & built on clean & flowing lines. Pleasing head shape with a good eye & expression, well made front assembly, firm topline & strong well rounded hindquarters for his age. Very sound on the move covering the ground on a free & easy stride. BPD & BP;

2nd Dyer & Oddie's Sharnphilly Secretariat, another very good baby who shows much promise. Well balanced throughout & presents a very pleasing outlook. Good head & eye, well developed body for his age with an excellent depth of chest. Best of quarters with a good bend of stifle.

Moved well;

3rd Smith's Sniperay Valencia at Tzaziki.

PUPPY DOG (5)

1st Dyer & Oddie's Sharnphilly Secretariat;

2nd Fleming's Glenariff Hendricks, this youngster impressed both on the stack & on the move. Not quite as together yet as the winner but another who I am sure will do very well with maturity. Pleasing head with a good eye & expression. Very clean over the neck & shoulders, good body shape, sound on the move;

3rd Sillince's Medogold Clown Prince for Tomlow.

JUNIOR DOG (6,1a)

1st Luke & Hinton's Fleurfield Jack Daniels, beautifully balanced throughout & one I seriously considered for top honours on the day, just needs a little more time, but another with a very promising future. Good head & eye, best of fronts standing on good legs & feet, well sprung ribs & excellent hindquarters. Moved soundly;

2nd Luke's Fleurfield Jim Beam, litter brother of the winner with many of the same virtues, just thought the winner had a little more scope at present than his sibling. Pleasing head shape, well made front, good depth of chest & a firm topline with a good tailset. Positive mover with good reach & drive;

3rd Marsh's Ratchda's Rock Thrush.

YEARLING DOG (6,1)

1st Tibbs' Fydal Beeswing at Raigmore, very well made & presents a very clean outline with those graceful curves the Standard asks for. Refined head with a good eye & soft expression. Pleasing front standing on the best of legs & feet, good depth, short coupled & strong well rounded quarters. Sound on the move;

2nd Saunder's Teisgol Double Trigger, pleasing shape, strongly made but shows no sign of coarseness. Balanced head, very clean over the neck & shoulders, well bodied with a good depth of chest & firm well muscled hindquarters. Once he got into his stride moved well;

3rd Luke's Teisgol Far Horizon for Fleurfield.

GRADUATE DOG (6,1)

1st Hazeltine & Welch's Just Wilburt by Hookwood, good size, beautifully balanced throughout & built on flowing lines. He has the required combination of elegance with strength & substance. Good head shape, fine leathers, very clean over the neck & shoulders, strong topline that he holds on the move & the best of quarters with a good bend of stifle. Very positive mover with excellent side gait. RCC;

2nd Tobin & Moss' Davigdor Reference Point, very pleasing type of overall good confirmation. Best of heads with a lovely soft expression. Well made front with a good depth of chest & plenty of heartroom. Firm short coupled body, strong hindquarters & well let down hocks. Moved well but his handler just has the tendency to go a little too fast with him;

3rd Wilson's Bonnygate Master Ghillie.

POST GRADUATE (8)

1st Saunder's Teisgol Massalia, balanced dog who needs to be handled to appreciate his many virtues. Very good head & eye, strong muscular neck set in well placed shoulders & the best of legs & feet. Well sprung ribs, firm topline, well rounded quarters & a good bend of stifle. Very sound on the move both fore & aft;

2nd Isherwood's Symitry Red Rascal, pleasing outlook with good bone & substance but still keeping that required elegance that is so typical of the breed. Balanced head with a pleasing expression, well made front, best of hindquarters with good width of second thigh. Moved soundly;

3rd Tibbs' Raigmore Astronomer Royal.

LIMIT DOG (13,3)

1st Tobin & Moss' Davigdor Rough And Tumble, beautifully made dog of good size who is so typical throughout. Quality refined head with that lovely chiselling under the eyes. Strong muscular neck set in well placed shoulders, excellent depth of chest, short coupled body, good tailset & strong well muscled quarters. Moved well to take this very competitive class but in the challenge not as steady on the move which cost him the chance for higher honours;

2nd Hazeltine & Upton's Hookwood By George, another very good dog who pushed the winner all the way. Built on clean & flowing lines & of good overall conformation. Pleasing head shape with a good eye & expression. Very clean over the neck & shoulders, good legs & feet, well sprung ribs & the best of hindquarters. Very positive on the move;

3rd Beesley's Ridanflight Rhodri at Birchleith.

OPEN DOG (5,1)

1st Howes' Millpoint Babe Magnet at Medogold, very impressive dog of excellent make & shape throughout & has that series of graceful curves from his head to tail that the Standard asks for. Balanced head with a very typical appearance, scores in neck & shoulders, straight front, well bodied with good depth, firm well muscled quarters & a pleasing bend of stifle. Such a sound impressive mover who covered the ground on a free & easy stride. CC & BOB;

2nd MaCara's Sh Ch Kanix Kingdom over Cromasaig, slightly different stamp & style to the winner but a very good dog who is soundly made & has a very impressive outlook. Pleasing head with a lovely eye & soft expression. Stands on good legs & feet, well made front assembly, firm well muscled body & the best of hindquarters. Moved soundly on a good stride;

3rd Martin's Sunhouse Anything Goes.

MINOR PUPPY BITCH (7,2)

1st Dyer & Oddie's Sharnphilly Makybe Diva, another quality puppy from this kennel. Lovely shape & so well balanced throughout. Good head & expression, pleasing front assembly with a good reach of neck set in well placed shoulders. Well developed body with a good spring of rib, firm topline, moved well;

2nd Elrington's Ansona Cinderella, pushed the winner close & I am sure another youngster with a very promising future. Good size with a very feminine outlook but has the required strength & substance to complete the picture. Balanced head, very clean over the neck & shoulders, firm quarters, sound on the move;

3rd Baker & Baker-Roullier's Desfrisa Flirtini.

PUPPY BITCH (9,2)

1st Fleming's Glenariff Quintessential, was very impressed with this quality puppy. Good size & presents a very balanced appearance. Pleasing head shape with a good eye & expression, straight front standing on good legs & feet, firm topline, excellent width of hindquarters with a good bend of stifle. Moved soundly on a free & easy stride. BPB;

2nd Dyer & Oddie's Sharnphilly Makybe Diva;

3rd Hewitt's Droveborough's Miss Marple.

JUNIOR BITCH (10,4)

1st Evans & Pavey's Joneva Mrs Bridges, did her well as a puppy & she is starting to develop now into the finished article. So beautifully put together & built on clean & flowing lines. Good head, eye & expression, best of fronts with a good layback of shoulder & return of upper arm that was lacking in many. Pleasing spring of rib, nicely rounded quarters & well let down hocks. Sound on the move;

2nd Stilgoe's Alcazar Amazing Grace via Teisgol, good shape & size & presents a very pleasing outlook. Balanced head with a very typical appearance. Well made front assembly, good depth of chest with plenty of heart room, short coupled & well developed hindquarters. Moved soundly both fore & aft;

3rd Norbury's Medogold Milk Shake.

YEARLING BITCH (5)

1st Bond's Joneva Asterea, litter sister to the junior winner & is of very similar make & shape to her sibling. Good size & of overall excellent conformation. Pleasing head with a good eye & kind expression. Straight front, good body shape & the best of quarters. Once she got into her stride moved well;

2nd Smith's Fydal Bedazzle, different stamp & style to the winner but a very nice bitch to go over. Well built & has those graceful curves throughout that the Standard asks for. Balanced head with a pleasing expression, well made front, good spring of rib, short coupled & good strength of loin. Sound on the move;

3rd Lowe's Lowsmoor Shiralee.

GRADUATE BITCH (5)

1st Swannell's Sharnphilly Rio Bella, very pleasing sort of good size & built on clean lines. Good head with a lovely eye & expression, excellent reach of neck set in well placed shoulders, firm body with a pleasing depth of chest & strong hindquarters. Soundest of movers both fore & aft;

2nd Metcalfe's Darkridge Busy Bein Fab'ulus, bitch of overall good make & shape with pleasing bone & substance but still has a feminine outlook. Nicely balanced, well made front assembly standing on good legs & feet & pleasing width of quarters. Moved well but not as positive as the winner on the day;

3rd Robert's Fanmatrix Oh What A Night.

POST GRADUATE BITCH (12,5)

1st MacKay's Federica Fanfare at Woodglade, cracking young lady who has that required combination of elegance with strength & substance throughout. Best of heads with a refined outlook & the softest of expressions. Very clean over the neck & shoulders, well sprung ribs, best of hindquarters & well let down hocks. She really comes into her own on the move, so sound & really covers the ground on a free & easy stride. CC;

2nd Hinton's Fleurfield Dances On A Dream, another very well made bitch of good type & presents a very pleasing outlook. Balanced head with a good eye & expression. Straight front standing on good legs & feet, well developed body, firm quarters with a good bend of stifle. Sound on the move;

3rd Tobin & Moss' Davigdor Diamond Lil.

LIMIT BITCH (12,2)

1st Ward's Kiswahili Timely Nu Edition to Jakobstown, such a sound honest bitch who is not exaggerated in anyway. Good size & of pleasing shape & presents a very balanced appearance. Typical in head with a good dark eye, well made front with a lovely depth of chest with plenty of heartroom. Firm topline, good tailset & nicely rounded hindquarters. Sound on the move;

2nd Bell's Ridanflight Runedd with Balintyne, another very pleasing sort who is so well made throughout & is built on clean & flowing lines. Good headpiece with the best of expressions. Pleasing reach of neck set in well placed shoulders, good spring of rib & strong well developed quarters with a good width of second thigh. Moved soundly;

3rd Brooksmith & Adams' Medogold Kiss N'Tell.

OPEN BITCH (3)

1st Edmondson & Robertshaw's Crookrise Agathis, one I have done well before & still hold her in high regard. So well put together with a very typical outlook. Quality refined head with that soft but bright expression. Best of fronts standing on good legs & feet, firm body, pleasing tailset & carriage, powerful hindquarters & a good bend of stifle. Such a sound positive mover with good reach & drive. RCC;

2nd Stuckey's Sh Ch Medogold Coralie of Pendan, another favourite of mine who I gave BP to the last time I judged the breed. Beautifully balanced throughout & she just flows in outline from head to tail. Lovely head & eye, pleasing reach of neck set in well placed shoulders, best of toplines, nicely angulated quarters & well let down hocks. Soundest of movers but on the day not the sparkle of the winner;

3rd Smith's Sh Ch Fydaal Ava.

VETERAN BITCH (1)

1st Stangroom's Lappakia Dune Song, alone but a very worthy winner. Lovely shape & very well built presenting a pleasing appearance. Balanced head with a good eye and expression. Very clean over the neck & shoulders, short coupled & firm well muscled hindquarters. Moves so soundly both fore & aft. BV.
