### **MINOR PUPPY DOG (4)**

1<sup>st</sup> Blackburn-Bennett's Kanix Obi at Stargang. A balanced puppy of a nice size. Dark eye, good head shape and well placed shoulders. Moved soundly and true for one so young. Well handled.

2<sup>nd</sup> Flint's Casilex Cognac. Lovely head with a dark eye. Needs more time. Not the topline of 1 on the move but he moved steadily.

3<sup>rd</sup> Tobin and Moss' Davigdor Corn Master

### **PUPPY DOG (4)**

1<sup>st</sup> Tibbs' Raigmore Beekeeper. Good head, neck and shoulders. Well balanced. Neat tail which he used on the move. Positive mover.

2<sup>nd</sup> Booth's Lundgarth Teal. A nice type with a kind expression. Very immature at the moment, time is on his side.

3<sup>rd</sup> Turnbull's Saregresi Keep Style at Beridew (Imp)

### **JUNIOR DOG (5, 2)**

1<sup>st</sup> Gordon and Petherick's Hawkfield Strider. Kind expression. Neat ears. Good forechest and overall balance but still needs to deepen a little. Moved out well.

2<sup>nd</sup> Martin's Sunhouse Chips Ahoy. A more mature boy than 1, masculine head, good neck and shoulders but longer in the loin. Neat tail which he used on the move.

3<sup>rd</sup> Astbury's Millpoint Simply In Step With Dorbury

### **GRADUATE DOG (7, 3)**

1<sup>st</sup> Parson's Pipeaway Hello Sunshine. This youngster is a lovely type with a good head and kind eye. He is deep in chest with good angulation and muscletone, just needs to get it together on the move.

2<sup>nd</sup> Adams' Millpoint Simply Smashing. Good head and body proportions although longer cast than 1. Well angulated fore and aft. Moved out well.

3<sup>rd</sup> Kirby's Pipeaway Master Design

### **POST GRADUATE DOG (11)**

1<sup>st</sup> O'Neill's Tenshilling Home Alone JW. Well balanced youngster of a nice type. Chiselled head with a dark eye. Good neck and shoulders. Sloping pasterns. He moved with good reach and drive.

2<sup>nd</sup> Marsh's Ratchda Rock Thrush. Taller than 1 and still needs time to mature but he is deep in chest and has all the essentials. Correct tailset but tended to move a little close behind.

3<sup>rd</sup> Turnbull's Bonnygate Marquis O'the Glen at Beridew

### **LIMIT DOG (14)**

1<sup>st</sup> Siddle's Wilchrimane C'mon Norbet. Lovely type with nice head proportions. Deep chest, good muscle tone and balanced fore and aft. Short tail which he used correctly. Not a flashy mover but very sound.

2<sup>nd</sup> Wilberg's Kanix Mario. Although larger than 1, another quality dog. Good spring of rib and shown in hard condition, he presents a typical picture on the stack and holds himself well on the move.

3<sup>rd</sup> Pattie's Hurwyn Masterchef

### **OPEN DOG (12, 2)**

1<sup>st</sup> Watkins and Davies' Sh Ch Hurwyn Law N'Order JW. Well shaped head with a kind expression, he has a lovely balanced outline and has matured into an elegant, stylish dog. He is masculine without exaggeration and is fit and well muscled which showed in his effortless stride around the ring. CC.

2<sup>nd</sup> Howes' Sh Ch Millpoint Babe Magnet at Medogold JW. Another quality dog, heavier in build than 1. Lovely head and expression, good length of neck into well laid shoulders. Presented in excellent condition. Moved with drive. RCC.

3<sup>rd</sup> Stilgoe's I Am the One and Only JW ShCM

### **MINOR PUPPY BITCH (6)**

1<sup>st</sup> Siddle's Wilchrimane Frankel (ai). This puppy oozes quality. She has a pretty, slightly dished head, straight front, good depth and well ribbed, with a firm topline and well muscled hindquarters. Very mature for her age and moves out with reach in front and plenty of drive behind. Well handled. BPIB. Delighted to see her go PG2.

2<sup>nd</sup> Blackburn-Bennett's Kanix Orient at Stargang. Smaller than 1 in build but a nice overall shape. Feminine with a good length of neck, good depth and angulation. Neat tail and moved well.

3<sup>rd</sup> Hinton's Christelle by Fleurfield

### **PUPPY BITCH (3)**

1<sup>st</sup> Howes' Whirly Bird. Attractive, nicely balanced puppy. Good angulation front and rear, well ribbed and deep in brisket. Shown in hard condition and moved with drive.

2<sup>nd</sup> Howes' Sugar Free. Litter sister to 1 and similar in style but more substantial all through, not as forward or as settled on the move.

3<sup>rd</sup> Guy and Lowe's Blueyonda Peaches at Carofel

### **JUNIOR BITCH (6, 2)**

1<sup>st</sup> Gordon's Hawkfield Saunter. Sweet head, sound construction with well laid shoulders and sloping pasterns. Elegant outline and a powerful mover but needs to settle in front movement.

2<sup>nd</sup> Fleetwood's Millpoint Simply I Catching. Longer cast and bigger all round than 1. Her head needs to break but she has a good length of neck and good angulation. Moved OK.

3<sup>rd</sup> Matthews' Millpoint Simply Bootiful with Sonham

### **GRADUATE BITCH (14, 5)**

1<sup>st</sup> Elrington's Ansona Cinderella. Beautiful head and expression. Lovely shape with good depth, strong over her loin and a well angulated rear. Moved well on good feet.

2<sup>nd</sup> Norbury's Medogold Milkshake at Heartbury JW. Smaller mould than 1, she has a pretty head and sweet expression. Stylish with a good front assembly and depth. Neat tail which she used correctly and moved steadily.

3<sup>rd</sup> Blowers' Fydal Blown Away to Deadaway

**POST GRADUATE BITCH (16, 2)**

1<sup>st</sup> Siddle, Siddle and Kruger's White Squall Seasyde Iced Tea (Imp) JW. Liked her for her breed type. Very feminine head with a gentle expression, dark eyes and pigment. Good shoulders, balance and angulation. Well muscled, strong hindquarters which allowed her to move around the ring with drive. RCC.

2<sup>nd</sup> Evans and Pavey's Joneva Mrs Bridges. Another good bitch, sweet head and bright expression. Strong neck into good front assembly with good depth. Well boned and stands on good feet. Shown in hard condition and moved with purpose and drive.

3<sup>rd</sup> Dyer, Dyer and Oddie's Calderside Truly Unruly for Riowood

**LIMIT BITCH (13, 2)**

1<sup>st</sup> Earl's Caithpoint Here and Now. Stylish bitch with a kind expression and dark eye. Good neck and shoulders. Elegant outline. Moved using her neat tail correctly.

2<sup>nd</sup> Bond's Joneva Asterea JW. Taller than 1 but another elegant, shapely girl. Good shaped head with dark eyes. Good bone and feet. Positive free mover.

3<sup>rd</sup> Dyke's Raigmore Starlet at Briartor

**OPEN BITCH (7, 1)**

1<sup>st</sup> McGilp's Sh Ch Ridanflight Ruby Tuesday at Forthbourne. Not the biggest but a classy girl who is very feminine with lovely breed type, pretty head and good body proportions. Shown in hard condition, carries her tail correctly and covered the ground with a good easy action driving from her hocks. CC and BOB.

2<sup>nd</sup> Rose's Ridanflight Rihanna. Slighter larger mould than 1. Another lovely type with a sweet expression, good bone, feet, body shape, good depth and a well angled backend.

Not as positive on the move.

3<sup>rd</sup> Brooksmith and Adams' Sh Ch Medogold Kiss'n'Tell JW ShCM
