### **PUPPY DOG (3)**

1<sup>st</sup> Tobin & Moss' Davigdor Corn Master. 8 months old o/w with pleasing head and good reach of neck. Well bodied with level top line and moderate angulation front and rear. Good tail set and when settled moved well. BPD

2<sup>nd</sup> Roberts' Kanix Othello B/W dog slightly younger than 1<sup>st</sup> which makes a lot of difference at this age. A little shorter in the neck but a well-balanced body and good bone throughout. Moved well.

3<sup>rd</sup> Booth's Lundgarth Teal.

### **JUNIOR DOG (5)**

1<sup>st</sup> O'Neill's Chesterhope Thrill Of T'chase (IMP NZ) Stylish o/w dog with well laid back shoulders and good depth of chest. Rib cage well back and nicely angulated rear quarters. Correct tail set and moved with style and drive.

2<sup>nd</sup> Adam' Millpoint Simply Smashing. L/W dog slightly longer cast than 1<sup>st</sup> and heavier in build. Nice expression and dark eye with deep brisket and solid quarters. Moved soundly.

3<sup>rd</sup> Jamieson's Kanix News Flash at Glenfinnan.

### **NOVICE DOG (1)**

1<sup>st</sup> Black's Raigmore Vasco De Gama. B/W dog, good front and well boned. Nicely angulated front and rear and moved with drive.

### **POST GRADUATE DOG (5)**

1<sup>st</sup> Marsh's Ratchda's Rock Thrush. L/W What a quality dog! Graceful and elegant with a masculine head and good reach of neck, well laid back shoulders and deep brisket. Well angulated hind quarters. Correct tail set. Moved soundly and with style. Delighted to give him his 1<sup>st</sup> CC and BOB.

2<sup>nd</sup> Hall's Gartarry You Shook Me. Heavier built than 1<sup>st</sup> but had pleasing head with dark pigmentation, strong neck and firm rear quarters, slightly lower tail set. Moved with purpose.

3<sup>rd</sup> Luke and Hinton's Fleufield Jim Beam.

### **LIMIT DOG (9)**

1<sup>st</sup> Luke and Hinton's Fleurfield Jack Daniels. Another quality dog with lovely head and expression, good reach of neck and well developed chest and with muscular rear angulation. Super outline on the move and pressed hard for the CC. RCC.

2<sup>nd</sup> Sillince's Medogold Clown Prince for Tomlow. B/W dog with good front with sloping pasterns, well lay back of shoulders. Good length of ribcage and strong rear quarters. Covered the ground well on the move.

3<sup>rd</sup> Perkins' Kanix Joker of Brent JW IR J CH SHCM.

### **OPEN DOG (3)**

1<sup>st</sup> Watkins & Davies' SH CH Hurwyn Law 'N' Order. Quality dog, presented in hard condition with strong head and correct shoulders. Well sprung ribs and well-muscled rear quarters. Moved well holding his top line.

2<sup>nd</sup> Howes' SH CH Millpoint Babe Magnet at Medogold JW. I judged this dog as a puppy and he has matured into a really quality dog. Just felt that 1<sup>st</sup> had the edge on him today. Good head and shoulders with deep brisket. Plenty of quality and had great drive round the ring.

3<sup>rd</sup> Wall's Meadowpoint Spirit of Fire.

### **VETERAN DOG (1)**

1<sup>st</sup> Whitham's Moordale Maritime at Sedgekirk. B/W dog with lovely expression and good pigmentation. Correct front with strong body and muscular rear quarters. Moved well with drive.

### **PUPPY BITCH (7)**

1<sup>st</sup> Howes' Medogold Whirly Bird. Heavier built bitch with kind expression. Long muscular neck into sloping shoulders. Good depth of chest with ribs carried well back. Strong hindquarters and well let down hocks. Moved with drive. BPIB

2<sup>nd</sup> Tobin & Moss' Davigdor Bee Wyched. Very pretty l/w bitch with kind expression, giving a lot away to 1<sup>st</sup> who is 1 year today. Nicely angulated front and solid body with good expanse of 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> thigh. A little hesitant on the move but when settled went well.

3<sup>rd</sup> Howes' Medogold Sugar Free.

### **JUNIOR BITCH (2)**

1<sup>st</sup> Callender's Kelval Kuga of Shambellie. Very feminine b/w bitch presented in lovely condition. Pretty head with good neck and shoulders, short coupled and firm hindquarters. Moved with confidence.

2<sup>nd</sup> Barker's Flinthill Orange Princess. Finer cast than 1<sup>st</sup> with a pretty head and well angulated front. Nice flowing lines throughout. Sound mover.

### **NOVICE BITCH (6)**

1<sup>st</sup> Turton's Joneva Mollie Malone for Hollybirch. A lovely bitch with super outline, lots of class. Correct front construction with good length of ribs and strong hindquarters. A sound mover.

2<sup>nd</sup> Howes' Medogold Whirly Bird.

3<sup>rd</sup> Howes' Medogold Sugar Free.

**POST GRADUATE BITCH (10, 1abs)** The best class of the day. Such quality bitches and I wish I had two or three 1<sup>st</sup>.

1<sup>st</sup> Elrington's Ansona Cinderella. Fabulous bitch presented in superb condition. Feminine head and good layback of shoulders. Deep chest and good length of back. Good rear angulation and nice tail set. Correct size. Moved superbly covering the ground well. Won the class on her quality. Well deserved her 1<sup>st</sup> CC.

2<sup>nd</sup> Evans and Pavey's Joneva Mrs Bridges. Another quality bitch who was unlucky to meet 1<sup>st</sup> in such superb condition and on another day could well change places. Lovely head and neck, well developed body and pleasing shape all over. Moved with drive.

3<sup>rd</sup> Cobden's Hawkfield Bronze for Alozia.

**LIMIT BITCH (5, 1 abs)**

1<sup>st</sup> Bond's Joneva Asterea. Litter sister to 2<sup>nd</sup> in previous class. Beautiful head with dark eye and kind expression. Clean neck and well placed shoulders. Body in good hard condition, with good width of thigh and well-turned stifle. Good mover using her tail to complete the picture. RCC.

2<sup>nd</sup> Howes' Medogold Lizette. Nicely made bitch with pleasant head and gentle expression. Good forequarters and plenty of substance throughout. Was rather reluctant on the move at first, but eventually found her stride and went well.

3<sup>rd</sup> Gill's Sunhouse Touch of Class for Diptonia.

**OPEN BITCH (4, 1abs) Three quality bitches.**

1<sup>st</sup> Brooksmith and Adams' SH CH Medogold Kiss 'N' Tell JW SHCM. Such a beautiful bitch presented in lovely condition with lovely head and nice dark eye, well defined stop. Good depth of chest reaching the elbow and nice tuck up. Strong back and short coupled with firm ear quarters and well set tail. Well handled and moved round the ring with drive.

2<sup>nd</sup> Stuckley's Medogold Coralie of Pendan JW SHCM. Litter sister to 1<sup>st</sup> and similar remarks apply, just felt that 1<sup>st</sup> had the edge on movement. Lovely shape with feminine head and

3<sup>rd</sup> Turton's Tanglebrook Madrilen.

**VETERAN BITCH (4).**

1<sup>st</sup> Fairbairn & Madigan's Misperros Jumanji of Carmelfair. Lovely bitch who looked really well at nearly 8 Very feminine head with straight front, good forearm angulation and nice spring of rib. Well constructed overall and presented a pleasing picture. Best Veteran.

2<sup>nd</sup> Dunn's Meadowpoint Spirit Dancer SHCM. 8.5 year old, slightly heavier build than 1<sup>st</sup>, in really good condition. Pretty head with nice front and rear angulation, good oval bone and level top line. Moved like a 2year old with lots of spark.

3<sup>rd</sup> Brooksmith and Adams' Smartbay Vintage Gold SHCM.
