### VETERAN DOG (1)

1<sup>st</sup> Harrison's Sh Millpoint Top Hat N Tails JW ShCM. B not showing his age at all. In super condition. A classic head, strong neck and shoulders onto a good front. Well muscled hindquarters with good turn of stifle, moved with drive. Stylish boy.

### MINOR PUPPY DOG (4)

1<sup>st</sup> Gerrard & Galloway's Sharnphilly Santorelli With Carmandine. 8 month b/w. Head with all the right levels. Well shaped baby just needs to mature. Carried his tail well.

2<sup>nd</sup> Saunders' Phlynnies Prince Of Thieves. B/w, well grown for his age. Good shaped head, correct ear set. Good lay of shoulder well bodied around. Good tail carriage but not as good on the move as first.

3<sup>rd</sup> Bell & Maddox's Luneville Dazzling Diamond At Owlpoint.

### PUPPY DOG (5, 1)

1<sup>st</sup> Blackburn-Bennett's Kanix Obi At Stargang. O/w of correct size and shape. Lovely eye shape, kind expression. Well placed neck onto well laid back shoulders. Sound front, well covered body strong hindquarters.

2<sup>nd</sup> Tobin & Moss' Davigdor Corn Master. Good shaped head, just didn't have the length of muzzle of first. Well covered all round, preferred the movement of first.

3<sup>rd</sup> Cooper & Pearson's Keepersfield Chevalier.

### JUNIOR DOG (8, 2)

1<sup>st</sup> O'Neill & O'Neill's Chesterhope Thrill Of T Chase (Imp). Hadn't seen this dog before but he took my eye straight away. O/w with a classic head, strong lean neck, well laid shoulders. Deep brisket, strong well muscled hindquarters with good turn of stifle. Held his topline on the move, covering the ground well with good tail action as he drove round the ring. CC & BOB.

2<sup>nd</sup> Jamieson's Kanix News Flash At Glenfinnan. Young dog with good pleasing head and expression. Clean neck, tight front. Good topline and tail set. Not quite the movement of first.

3<sup>rd</sup> Astbury's Millpoint Simply In Step With Dorbury.

### YEARLING DOG (4)

1<sup>st</sup> Adams' Millpoint Simply Smashing JW. B/w with a lot to like. Head with all the right levels, ears of medium length set right. Neck clean long and muscular. Good lay of shoulder, good spring of rib. Moved well using his strong hindquarters.

2<sup>nd</sup> Dyer & Oddie's Sharnphilly Secretariat. B/w, good head, neck and front. Short coupled well covered body, moved well.

3<sup>rd</sup> Astbury's Millpoint Simply In Step With Dorbury.

### GRADUATE DOG (3, 1)

1<sup>st</sup> Collins' Callholme John Paul. Lovely stylish b/w dog. Loved his head and his lovely soft expression. Strong neck onto well angulated shoulders, just right in body condition. Real drive on the move carrying his tail well.

2<sup>nd</sup> Matt's & Matt's Churchill Private Big Jim. B/w dog in good condition and coat. Pleasing outline, just not as preferred movement of first, but used his tail well.

### **POST GRADUATE DOG (8)**

1<sup>st</sup> Sillince's Medogold Clown Prince For Tomlow. I liked the outline and balance of this dog. Good in body all round. Pleasing head, clean neck leading to good shoulder placement. Sound front, good spring of rib, strong in hindquarters. A lot to like, moved well.

2<sup>nd</sup> Turnbull's Marquis O' The Glen At Beridew. Lovely head, long clean neck, well laid shoulders, good turn of stifle.

3<sup>rd</sup> Lathwell's Tinchitamba A Waiting Game.

### **LIMIT DOG (14, 4)**

1<sup>st</sup> Beesley's Ridanflight Rhodri At Birchleith. O/w stronger type of dog with everything in the right place. Lovely outline. This dog just took over the ring on the move covering the ground well and his well carried tail lashing from side to side. Best mover of the day. RCC.

2<sup>nd</sup> Marsh's Ratchda Rock Thrush. Liv/w lovely headed dog, clean neck onto well laid shoulders. Muscular hindquarters. Did not show to his advantage today.

3<sup>rd</sup> Rayner, Spinks & Pringle's Freebreeze Over The Top At Spinray.

### **OPEN DOG (8,1)**

1<sup>st</sup> Bradley's Teisgol King Alfred At Dappledawn. Classic headed b/w with lovely expression. Clean neck, good lay of shoulder, sound front. Well balanced all through, moved with drive.

2<sup>nd</sup> Hazeltine & Upton's Hookwood By George JW ShCM. Lovely headed dog. Well angulated front and rear. In top condition, moved well, but tail a little high for me.

3<sup>rd</sup> Harrison's Sh Ch Millpoint Heat Wave JW ShCM.

### **VETERAN BITCH (3, 1)**

1<sup>st</sup> Booth's Galema Iona. B/w with lovely feminine head and expression. In good all round condition. Well put together, good spring of rib, deep brisket. Moved with drive using tail well.

2<sup>nd</sup> Stangroom's Lappakia Dune Song. Stood a little taller but good neck onto well laid shoulders. Good depth moved well.

### **MINOR PUPPY BITCH (6, 1)**

1<sup>st</sup> McGilp's Forthbourne Firefly. Very smart 6 month o/w. Shape of head just right for age. Lovely ears, good in body moved well.

2<sup>nd</sup> Perkins' Brent Hothouse Flower. O/w a little heavier all round, stronger in head. In good condition, moved well, just needs time.

3<sup>rd</sup> Dyer & Oddie's Sharnphilly Vera Wang.

### **PUPPY BITCH (6)**

1<sup>st</sup> Hinton's Keepersfield Chris Tells With Fleurfield. Another bitch that really takes the eye. B/w lovely head, clean neck, good lay of shoulder, sound front. Good spring of rib, strong well angulated quarters, moved well. BPIB.

2<sup>nd</sup> Siddle & Crocker's Wilchrimane Frankel (ai). O/w, feminine head, sweet expression. Long muscular neck, good lay of shoulder. Condition very good, moved well using her tail.

3<sup>rd</sup> McGilp's Forthbourne Front Page.

### **JUNIOR BITCH (5, 3)**

1<sup>st</sup> Mathews' Millpoint Simply Bootifull With Sonham. Striking b/w young bitch. Head of right proportions, lovely eyes and expression and ears. Strong neck, well sprung ribs. Stylish outline, moved well.

2<sup>nd</sup> Guy & Lowe's Blueyonda Peaches At Carofel. O/w, lovely headed and well constructed all round. Preferred movement of first but she used her tail well.

3<sup>rd</sup> Howes' Medogold Sugar Free.

**YEARLING BITCH (6, 2)**

1<sup>st</sup> Metcalfe's Darkridge Witchy Woman. O/w with lovely balanced feminine head. Sound front, arched neck flowing onto good shoulders. Good depth of brisket. Strong hindquarters, good turn of stifle, moved with drive.

2<sup>nd</sup> Elrington's Ansona Cinderella JW. B/w, liked her outline and pleasing head. Well angulated and muscled all round, preferred movement of first.

3<sup>rd</sup> Arams' Sharnphilly Auroras Encore For Aramaston.

**GRADUAET BITCH (5)**

1<sup>st</sup> Howes' Medogold Whirly Bird. L/w. I loved her overall outline. Feminine Head and expression. Arched neck flowing onto good shoulders and topline. Sound front, well sprung strong well angulated hindquarters. In lovely condition, moved well, one to like.

2<sup>nd</sup> Cobden's Hawkfield Bronze Of Alozia. A finer type than first. Lovely head, kind expression. In good condition all round. Moved with drive covering the ground well.

3<sup>rd</sup> Westaway's Ridanflight Raisen.

**POST GRADUATE BITCH (5, 2)**

1<sup>st</sup> Stilgoe & Oliver's Aster Lightening Star Via Teisgol JW. Pleasing head with good eye shape, kind expression. Arched clean neck onto good lay of shoulder, sound front. Well covered well muscled body. Strong muscled hindquarters, good use of tail on the move.

2<sup>nd</sup> Lowe's Lowsmoor Shiralee JW. O/w with lovely feminine head and expression, reachy neck, sound front, well angulated hindquarters, moved well holding her topline tail just a little high.

3<sup>rd</sup> O'Neill's Tenshilling Home Alone JW.

**LIMIT BITCH (15,2)**

1<sup>st</sup> Evans & Pavey's Joneva Mrs Bridges JW. Lovely type head with all the right proportions. Arched neck flowing onto good shoulders and topline. Pleasing front, correct feet, deep well sprung chest, well muscled hindquarters, good turn of stifle. Moved with drive. Well presented. RBCC.

2<sup>nd</sup> Siddle & Kruger's White Squall Seasyde Iced Tea (Imp) JW.

3<sup>rd</sup> Swannel's Sharnphilly Rio Bella.

**OPEN BITCH (5-1)**

1<sup>st</sup> Brooksmith & Adams' Sh Ch Medowgold Kiss N Tell JW ShCM. Super quality L/w. Well defined feminine head, sweet expression, good ears. Well angulated fore and hindquarters. Good spring of rib, strong to line on the move using her powerful quarters to drive round the ring. Lovely bitch. BCC.

2<sup>nd</sup> Roses' Ridenflight Rhianna. O/w. Lovely balanced head, good front legs and feet. Pleasing topline, good hindquarters, well turned stifle, moved well.

3<sup>rd</sup> McGilp's Sh Ch Ridanflight Ruby Tuesday At Forthbourne.

**GOOD CITIZE DOG SCHEME BITCH (5, 1)**

1<sup>st</sup> Vaughn's Teisgol I Am What I Am. B/w with good head and front assembly. Arched neck good spring of rib. Well angulated, moved well.

2<sup>nd</sup> Stangroom's Pipeaway Laura Louisa At Lappakia ShCM. O/w taller bitch not quite together as first. Moved well.

3<sup>rd</sup> Lathwell's Tinchitamba A Waiting Game.
