Today just preferred return of upper arm and low stride of winner.

2nd Stilgoe's Glenariff Mojito over Teisgol, b/w, such a pleasing flow on this boy, everything in balance, moves on a light free stride with good tail action, hard decision but just preferred work in head of winner today.

3rd Ganney, Norbury and Adams' Fisherbloom Hey Didle Didle at Heartbury.

1st Oddie's Chesterhope One Way Ticket (ai), b/w, liked the flow and balance of this boy, fine coat, head with full kind eyes, raised brows and muscular arched neck, correct oval bone he flowed down through well sprung ribs and moved out with purpose and drive. Presented in well muscled condition. CC BOB 2nd Martin's Sh Ch Sunhouse Banged To Rights, b/w, different in type, bigger boy who fits the standard well, head is nicely moulded with nice expression, he flows from nose to tail and moved on a light stride with ground covering movement and good tail action. RCC 3rd Martin's Sunhouse You're Nicked.

VETERAN DOG (2 ents, 0 abs)

1st Welch & Hazeltine's Pytchley Chasing The Dream for Hookwood JW, b/w, have always liked this boy, his topline flows nicely, good rib and depth, head well worked with kind expressive eyes. He strode out well 2nd Philo's Fydal Caprio at Salmonmist ShCM OSW ShCEx, o/w, different mould to one, nice chiselling to head, dark eye, neat tail.

MINOR PUPPY BITCH (4 ents, 1 abs) At very differing stages, though all 3 showed promise.

1st Gerrard, Bell & Galloway's Riowood C'mon Its Time for Carmandine, b/w, nice puppy, well defined head such a mischievous expression from her dark eyes, fine ears and good arch to neck, moved out with reach using her neat tail well.
