VETERAN DOG (2)

1st O'Neill's Sh Ch Tenshilling Home Alone JW ShCM. Best Veteran. Looking fabulous for 9 years old. Lovely well-balanced head of correct proportions with nice eye and expression. Well-made throughout, excellent front angulation, good depth of chest and strong topline. Excellent width of upper & lower thigh; well let down hocks. Good feet and correct oval bone. Moved correctly with lots of drive.

2nd Bowen-Brooks' Tenshilling Blowin Smoke. 7 years old. Pleasing head with nice eye & expression. Good strength of neck and nice depth of chest. Good tailset, oval bone. Moved a little close behind.

MINOR PUPPY DOG – No entries

PUPPY DOG (5)

1st Harrison's Millpoint Watson. Lovely masculine outline with mature body for age. Well defined head with concave muzzle and slight depression under eyes. Excellent neck, shoulder & depth of chest. Nice bend of stifle & well let-down hocks. Good topline & tail set. Strong loin for age. Covered the ground well on the move.

2nd O'Neill's Tenshilling Shboom. Another nice one, just a little heavier in the head than 1, but not overdone. Excellent length of neck. Good forechest & depth of chest. Good width of upper & lower thigh. Nice topline and strong loin. Moved typically & soundly fore & aft covering the ground well.

3rd Fox & Stigoe's Teisgol Magic

JUNIOR DOG (2)

1st Harrison's Millpoint Winchester. A bit erratic on the move, but front movement more typical than that of 2. Nice length of head with dark, expressive eyes. Excellent length of neck and good forequarters. Nice topline & tailset. Good oval bone and well-muscled throughout. Moved soundly when settled.

2nd Clinton's Hawkfield Happy Feet at Oramiss. Not quite as mature as 1 but lovely head, eye & expression. Lots of work in the head and displaying large open nose. Excellent length of neck & well-placed shoulders. Good forechest, well let down hocks. Good feet.

NOVICE DOG (3, 1)

1st Harrison's Millpoint Winchester

2nd Newcombe's Kimifleur Hercules. A lovely example of the breed. Nice eye & expression; large open nose. Nicely shaped in skull in muzzle. Excellent angulation fore & aft. Good depth of chest; nice oval bone. Good topline. Moved soundly & correctly once settled.

POST GRADUATE DOG (9, 1) First two had the best outlines in the class.

1st Webb's Tenshilling Jimmy Mack JW. Lovely head, eye & expression. Nice length of head & sufficient width of skull. Masculine but not overdone. Nice earset, large open nose. Good bone. Excellent length of slightly arched neck. Good lay of shoulder & return of upper arm. Excellent depth of chest. Good topline, firm loin & well-angulated hindquarters. Well-muscled throughout. Moved typically with pleasing head & tail carriage giving a balanced workmanlike appearance on the move.

2nd Keaney's Flinthill Hot Mail. Another lovely outline and head with correct depression under eye. Nice stop and pronounced occipital bone. Excellent width of chest & good oval bone. Correct topline, excellent width of upper & lower thigh. Well let down hocks. Moved soundly when settled.

3rd Mennen & Sweeney's Joneva Just Imagine JW.

LIMIT DOG (5)

1st Adams' Carofel Wings Of Hope JW WW23 Swiss Jr Ch. Lovely in outline and caught my eye on the first move around the ring. Well constructed throughout with good forechest. Excellent neck, depth of chest & nice topline. Good bone & feet. Lovely eye & expression with well-shaped muzzle and skull giving a masculine appearance but not overdone. Large open nose. Moved covering the ground well, typically & correctly.

2nd Lewis' Kanix Snapdragon at Fallowfield. Another one with a pleasing balanced outline. Gorgeous head & expression. Nice overall length of head. Excellent neck, lay of shoulder & return of upper arm. Well-muscled throughout. Good depth of chest, well let down hocks. Moved soundly fore & aft.

3rd Wybergh's Stocksfell Chase The Ace.

OPEN DOG (6)

1st Oddie's Sh Ch Sharnphilly Boondoggle JW. CC. So well balanced, caught my eye on the first run around the ring. Lovely head with well defined and correctly- shaped skull and muzzle, nice eye colour, shape & expression. Large open nose; nice earset. Good length & strength of neck. Excellent lay of shoulder & return of upper arm. Excellent depth of chest, bone & feet. Good width of upper & lower thigh and well let down hocks. Good tailset. Moved covering the ground well with typical smooth action.

2nd Martin & Martin's Sh Ch Sunhouse Banged To Rights. Res CC. Another lovely smooth and sound moving dog with all the essentials. Balanced outline. Lovely masculine head with nice eye & slight depression under the eye. Good length of head. Nice width in front; excellent spring of rib; good oval bone. Well-muscled throughout.

3rd Oliver & Stilgoe's Teisgol Love Is In The Air

SPECIAL BEGINNERS DOG (3)

1st Bowen-Brooks's Tenshilling Here I Go Again. Best Special Beginner. Nicely balanced in outline. Good length of head; nice width and depth of chest. Good strength and length of neck. Correct angulation fore & aft. Well let down hocks. Nice topline & tailset. Covered the ground well on the move.

2nd Newcombes's Kimifleur Hercules.

3rd Pratt's Hawkfield Wickham.

VETERAN BITCH - No entries

MINOR PUPPY BITCH (1)

1st Oddie's Riowood Tick Tick Boom to Sharnphilly Naf Taf. Best Puppy. Lovely outline & well-developed head for age. Lovely eye & expression, open nose. Excellent neck, forechest, lay of shoulder & return of upper arm. Good depth of chest for age. Excellent width of upper & lower thigh. Nice topline, bone & feet. Moved covering the ground well once settled.

JUNIOR BITCH (2, 1)

1st Brock's Zoalin Better Together. Lovely young bitch with excellent head proportions. Nice eye with slight depression underneath; large open nose. Excellent angulation fore & aft. Good depth of chest; nice strength over loin. Good bone & feet. Moved soundly covering the ground well.

NOVICE BITCH (2)

1st Brock's Zoalin Better Together.

2nd Dunn's Millpoint Kiss Me Kate at Casdellda. A little lacking in confidence but lovely in outline. Feminine head with nice eye, good length of head & large open nose. Excellent angulation throughout. Well-muscled. Good topline. Covered the ground on the move but needs a little more confidence to complete the picture.

POST GRADUATE BITCH (11, 1)

1st Stilgoe & Oliver's Teisgol Heaven Sent JW. Caught my eye on entering the ring. Lovely to go over with an outline full of curves. Feminine well-balanced head with well-defined occipital bone. Open nose, nice ear set & shape of ear. Excellent forechest, depth of chest & spring of rib. Slightly arched neck well set onto shoulders. Good width of upper & lower thigh. Well let-down hocks. Moved soundly & typically with good head carriage & lashing tailmovement.

2nd Martin & Martin's Sunhouse Black T'square One (ai). Lovely outline. Fabulous head with excellent eye & expression. Large open nose. Excellent head and skull proportions & nice width of skull. Good length & strength of neck. Nice angulation throughout. Good oval bone. Excellent depth of chest; nice tailset.

Moved soundly & typically covering the ground well with each stride.

3rd Earl, Wheldon & Jones' Flinthill Some Like It Hot at Caithpoint.

LIMIT BITCH (5, 1) My first two were both very pleasing examples of the breed, just preferred the detail in the head of 1.

1st Moss's Davigdor Poppies. Res CC. Lovely head of good length with dark expressive eye. Well defined stop and nicely pronounced occipital bone. Excellent length & strength of neck. Well-laid shoulder with complementary return of upper arm & good forechest. Good spring of rib; nice strength over loin. Good width of upper & lower thigh and well let down hocks. Good oval bone throughout. Nice oval, well-arched feet. Moved covering the ground well.

2nd Fewster & Rossiter's Joneva Just A Kiss JW. Lovely in outline so full of curves. Nice eye & expression.

Good earset & shape of ear. Good length and strength of neck, lay of shoulder & return of upperarm.

Pleasing rear angulation, nice topline & tailset. Moved soundly both coming and going on well-arched feet.

3rd Dunn's Millpoint Heart And Soul at Casdellda.

OPEN BITCH (4)

1st Siddle, Siddle & Medeiros' Wilchrimane Frankly Darlin. CC & BOB. I was absolutely delighted to watch her win the group. Won here on fabulous outline full of curves and smooth ground covering movement so straight in front & behind. Shown in excellent muscular condition throughout. Nice eye & expression. Good stop and large open nose. Well defined occipital bone. Good lay of shoulder and return of upper arm. Excellent forechest, depth of chest and spring of rib. Good width of upper & lower thigh, well let-down hocks. Moved so well with correct lashing side to side tail action.

2nd Webb's Sh Ch Tenshilling The Wanderer. Another lovely example, nicely balanced in outline. Pleasing eye colour & expression. Correct long, slightly arched neck & good lay of shoulder. Good depth of chest, strong in loin and excellent width of upper & lower thigh. Nice oval bone throughout. Moved soundly covering the ground well.

3rd Booth's Sharnphilly Ginger Fizz at Lundgarth.
